As you prayerfully consider participating in a "Freedom Appointment", let us share some important information that may be helpful to you.

[Set Free Ministries]

For several years, Mars Hill has partnered with the folks at Set Free Ministries in Grand Rapids for the purpose of providing our community a safe + private place to participate in Freedom appointments. There is no cost for a Freedom appointment.

[Confidential Personal Inventory]

This is also known as a CPI. Please set aside some quiet time and fill out the CPI as completely and accurately as possible. Then, mail it directly to Set Free Ministries, Attn: Nancy, at: 700 – 36<sup>th</sup> St SE, Suite 108, Grand Rapids MI 49548. The information will be shared only with the prayer partner(s) that will be assisting during your appointment time, which takes place at the Set Free Ministry office.

[Recommended Reading]

Please read, or review, the books *The Bondage Breaker* by Neil Anderson and *Waking the Dead* by John Eldredge. The process used for the appointment can be found in chapter 13 of *The Bondage Breaker*. For additional information that is helpful, please read *Victory Over the Darkness* by Neil Anderson. We believe that reading these books will enhance your growth experience.

[Freedom Appointment]

Plan on at least a 5-hour block of time. Some appointments require less or more time. If more time is required, your prayer partner(s) will help you determine extending the length of time that day, or perhaps scheduling a second appointment. However, it is recommended that you complete the process in one appointment. On page 9 of the CPI form, please indicate the best possible dates + times you are available. And, bring a brown bag lunch/dinner.

[Prayer Partner]

You will be assigned a prayer partner for your appointment time. If you prefer to bring someone you know as a prayer partner, please indicate that person's name + relationship to you, on page 9 of the CPI form. We suggest that person not be a spouse or an immediate family member. It's most beneficial if that person is also familiar with the recommended reading materials.

[Prayer]

We encourage you to prepare yourself with prayer and God's word. It's helpful to study the verses that correspond to the "Who Am I?" Statements found in both *The Bondage Breaker* and *Victory Over the Darkness*. It's not unusual to experience increased spiritual oppression before an appointment. Our enemy does not want you to experience the fullness of freedom, but God assures you that you have authority to resist those possible attacks in Jesus' name [James 4:7; 1 John 4:4].
